The Mississippi Department of Marine Resources is recruiting for four (4) DMR-Marine Patrol Officer II positions. **These positions are time-limited and will be funded** by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), Department of Homeland Security (DHS) Port Security Grant (PSG). **Continuation of these positions is contingent upon availability of funding.**

The incumbents will fulfill duties of a Marine Patrol Officer while intensifying a Public Presence at either the Port of Pascagoula or the Port of Gulfport. When necessary, the officers will assist with calls of service to the noted ports of entry, assist with federal fisheries patrols, and other duties pertaining to homeland security. Incumbents are assigned to one of the two ports, working 10-12 hours per day on a 28-day work cycle, working on holidays, weekends, and nights. The annual salary for these positions is \$38,887.53.
