QUESTION 1: How many hours, days etc. On-call based on tours or set amount of hours daily?

ANSWER 1: These positions will be on-call, based on tours. The GBNERR will generally schedule boat tours two weeks in advance, however, some boat tours may be scheduled with less notice, but no less than forty-eight (48) hours in advance. Boat tours will generally be 3-4 hours, but some tours may take up to eight hours. There will be approximately 6-10 boat tours throughout the year. Additional time may be incurred assisting with Coast Guard inspections, conducting safety briefings for the crew before boat operation, and periodically conducting safety drills (both dry and in operation) for GBNERR staff and crew training purposes. Boat tours will take place Monday through Saturday and will mostly occur within the waters of the GBNERR, between Bayou Heron and Bayou Cumbest, Point Aux Chenes and Bangs Lake, however, longer trips outside the Reserve to Round Island, other barrier islands or Biloxi, may also occur.

QUESTION 2: Is this a temporary contract, seasonal, or year-round?

ANSWER 2: Contracts will be for one year.
