Deadline approaching for Celebrate the Gulf poster contest

BILOXI, Miss. – Organizers of the Celebrate the Gulf Marine Education Festival have announced that the deadline to enter the event's second annual poster contest is Jan. 14, 2016.

Amateur and professional artists are encouraged to submit an original poster design that depicts the conservation or scenic qualities of Mississippi's coastal resources for consideration as the event's poster.

The winning artist will receive \$250 and 10 posters.

Celebrate the Gulf is put on by the Mississippi Department of Marine Resources and is held in conjunction with Art in the Pass. This year's festivals will be held Saturday, April 2, 2016, at War Memorial Park in Pass Christian.

Rules:

- Artwork must be camera ready.
- Only original artwork will be accepted.
- No entry fee is required.
- Artist must be 13 years of age or older to participate.
- No size restrictions, but final print size will be about 16 X 20 inches.
- Each artist may submit up to two entries for consideration.
- Computer-generated art is NOT acceptable.
- Artwork should depict Mississippi's coastal resources.
- Employees of the MDMR and their immediate family members are not eligible for the contest.
- The design must be suitable for poster reproduction and be in keeping with the family atmosphere of the festival.
- When submitted, the artwork must be sprayed with a fixative (if appropriate), covered with acetate or clear plastic wrap and be supported in front and back with corrugated or foam core board for protection.
- Entry deadline Jan. 14, 2016, 5 p.m.
- Each submission must be accompanied by a completed entry form, which is available at dmr.ms.gov.
- The decision of the judges is final.

- The winning artist must attend the festival and sign the posters on April 2, 2016, from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.
- The submission selected will become the sole property of the MDMR. The MDMR will also retain the right to use the artists' names in any present and/or future promotional or educational activities.
- Winning artwork will be unveiled in February.

Entries and accompanying paperwork must be submitted to Jessica Rankin at the MDMR, 1141 Bayview Avenue, Biloxi, MS 39530.
