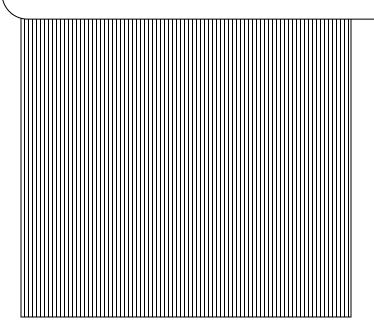

Dear Legislative Budget Committee Member:

Enclosed is the FY 2021 budget request for the Mississippi Department of Marine Resources (MDMR). The MDMR is requesting additional funding to meet the legislative mandates given to the agency. We have been committed to meeting the goals of our agency's mission while remaining fiscally responsible. In previous years, federal and other non-state sources of revenue were used to offset the decrease in general funds (i.e. disaster recovery funds related to Hurricane Katrina and BP oil spill). However, these one-time funds have been expended and are no longer available to meet our normal budget shortfalls. It is now necessary to request a budget increase in State Appropriations to help offset some of the Federal and Non-Federal funding decreases.

In 2014, the Mississippi Legislature passed SB 2579, the MDMR Accountability and Reorganization Act. This legislation requires an annual self-funded audit of the agency and establishes new offices and senior staff positions. We have worked hard to reorganize the agency to meet the legislative intent of SB 2579 and believe the results are showing.

We look forward to providing essential law enforcement, marine science, coastal restoration and regulatory functions for the State of Mississippi. Please feel free to contact me at any time should the committee have questions regarding this request.

STATE SUPPORT SPECIAL FUNDS

The agency is not requesting any State Support Special Funds at this time.

FEDERAL FUNDS

Federal funds received during FY 2019 were from the U.S. Department of Commerce (NOAA), U.S. National Park Service and the U.S. Department of Interior (Fish and Wildlife Service).

Funds from the U.S. Department of Commerce are used to fund Mississippi Coastal Programs, Fisheries Research projects, the Grand Bay National Estuary Research Reserve and the Joint Enforcement Agreement.

Funds from the U.S. Department of Interior are used to fund research projects and fisheries stock assessment, enhancement and public access projects, and public information and education projects.

Funds from the U.S. National Park Service are used to fund projects designated in the Mississippi Gulf Coast Heritage Area. All federal funds, though unencumbered, are obligated for specific projects.

Off-road Fuel Taxes - \$3,050,000

Derived by the State Tax Commission through the collection of gasoline, diesel fuel, or kerosene taxes and remitted to the DMR via our appropriation bill. Apportionment based on MS Code 27-5-101(b)(iv).

Saltwater License Fees- \$1,095,000

Fees are derived from the sale of saltwater recreational and commercial licenses.

Other Non-Federal Revenues

Included in these funds are the following non-recurring funds:

Specific purpose Funds

The MDMR receives other funds that are included in income and the cash balances but do not represent cash available for general operations. The funding for the projects in this category is obligated for a specific purpose. BP Seafood Marketing and Testing

On April 20, 2010, an explosion and fire occurred on the Deepwater Horizon drilling platform, operated by British Petroleum, Inc. (BP), in the Northern Gulf of Mexico resulting in the loss of life, the subsequent sinking of the rig and a massive oil spill. Due to the effects of this event, the DMR received funds to test seafood and also promote Mississippi Seafood nationwide. In FY2018 the DMR did not receive any new funds for marketing.

GOMESA

Gulf of Mexico Energy Security Act funds used for coastal restoration projects.

Shell Retention

MDMR collects a fee for oyster shells taken from the waters of the state of Mississippi. Per MS code, the funds received from the fee are set aside to further oyster production in this state, which includes plantings of oysters and/or cultch materials.

NFWF (National Fish and Wildlife Foundation) FY21 Projections (5345100000) - \$6,462,978

These funds are expected as the result of the BP Oil Spill Settlement that went to NFWF and subsequently MDEQ. MDMR will expects project activity at an estimated \$6,462,978 in FY21 to perform special projects and will be reimbursed for actual expenditures for work done.

NFWF, whose primary purpose is to restore and protect our nation's fish, wildlife, plants and habitats, supports conservation efforts in all 50 states and U.S. territories.

GOMESA Phase II FY21 Projections (3345300000) - \$30,000,000

In FY18, we established a new fund for GOMESA Phase II to track Phase II revenues & expenditures separately. The first deposit from GOMESA Phase II revenues was received in April 2018. The second deposit was received in April 2019. We are requesting budget authority for FY21 based on the actual amount received with authority to escalate up to \$30,000,000. Purpose of GOMESA Phase II:

To be used in accordance with all applicable Federal and State laws, only for 1 or more of the following purposes A) Projects and activities for the purposes of coastal protection, including conservation, coastal restoration, hurricane protection, and infrastructure directly affected by coastal wetland losses B) mitigation of damage to fish, wildlife or natural resources; C) implementation of a federally-approved marine, coastal or comprehensive conservation management plan; D) Mitigation of the impact of Outer Continental Shelf activities through the funding of onshore infrastructure projects; E) Planning assistance and the administrative costs of complying with this section.

Treasury Fund 3345000000 (3450) is the "Seafood Fund" set up in the State Statute that is used to collect funds such as off-road fuel tax and other special funds. The other funds, though unencumbered are obligated for a particular purpose/program as described above.

Treasury Fund 5345000000 (349G) is DMR's Grant Clearing Fund. In FY2018, DMR utilized a separate fund to enable better control and tracking of reimbursable grant funds. Almost all of grant funds are on a reimbursement basis so this fund will always have a zero or slightly negative balance.

Treasury Fund 5345100000 is DMR's NFWF (National Fish and Wildlife Foundation) Clearing Fund. In FY2018, DMR utilized a separate fund to enable better control and tracking of special reimbursable funds from National Fish and Wildlife Foundation (NFWF) granted through MDEQ to MDMR which was part of another BP Settlement.

Treasury Fund 3345300000 is DMR's GOMESA Phase II Fund. In FY2018, DMR utilized a separate fund to enable better control and tracking of special reimbursable funds from revenues received for Phase II of the Gulf of Mexico Energy Security Act (GOMESA).

The License Clearing Account is used for collection of license fees, confiscated catch fees, fines for violations, and other miscellaneous fees. These are transferred to the State Treasury for deposit in the DMR's Seafood Fund.

The Special Permit Account is a clearing account for collection of wetlands permit fees. These funds are transferred to the State Treasury for deposit in the DMR's Seafood Fund.

NARRATIVE 2021 BUDGET REQUEST

Department of Marine Resources (450-00)

Name of Agency

The Mississippi Gulf Coast is home to some of the nation's most productive shellfish and finfish waters and their supporting coastal wetlands and is rich in natural resources. Many generations have depended on these resources for their livelihoods. Our coastal resources have not only sustained a growing economy, but have contributed greatly to the culture and heritage that define Coast natives as a people.

The Mississippi Department of Marine Resources (MDMR) was created by the state Legislature in 1994. Before then, the agency was a bureau under the state Department of Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks. The MDMR manages our coastal resources under the authority of the Commission on Marine Resources (CMR).

The MDMR is dedicated to enhancing, protecting and conserving the marine interests of Mississippi for present and future generations. It manages all marine life, public trust wetlands and waterfront areas for the long-term recreational, educational, commercial and economic benefit of everyone in the state.

The MDMR and the CMR play an important role in administering Mississippi seafood laws, as well as these acts: Mississippi Coastal Wetlands Protection, Public Trust Tidelands, Boat and Water Safety, Derelict Vessels, Marine Litter and other state and federal mandates.

FY 2021 Request - The MDMR is requesting a total budget authority of \$54,799,941. We are requesting additional Appropriations in the amount of \$270,000.00 to fund replacement of several of Marine Patrol's aging fleet.

Total Budget Authority Changes are detailed below:

Program 3 - Tideland & Trust Fund is in a separate budget request, 452-00.

Marine Patrol - Continuation of Existing Activities - \$270,000

Vehicles - \$270,000 in vehicle costs is based on the request to purchase and outfit eight (8) F-250 trucks to replace aged vehicles in the Marine Patrol fleet of vehicles due to increased maintenance costs.

Finance And Administration - Continuation of Existing Activities - \$25,000,000

Contractual - \$5,000,000 in contractual costs in Other Special Funds is based on the continuation of services rendered from existing and projected DMR projects for GOMESA Ph II cost projections.

Commodities - \$2,000,000 in commodities in Other Special Funds is based on the continuation of services rendered from existing and projected DMR projects for GOMESA Ph II cost projections.

Subsidies - \$18,000,000 in subsidies costs in Other Special Funds is based on the continuation of services rendered from existing and projected DMR projects for GOMESA Ph II cost projections.
