

**NOTICE OF DERELICT VESSEL PROCEEDINGS TO  
ALL UNKNOWN PERSONS CLAIMING ANY INTEREST IN THE FOLLOWING VESSEL:**

The Mississippi Department of Marine Resources (MDMR) has determined that the vessel described below constitutes a derelict vessel pursuant to Miss. Code Ann. §49-27-71.

A Derelict Vessel Removal Notice was placed on this vessel on or about October 27, 2022 with a removal date of October 29, 2022. You (any interested party) are hereby notified that the vessel must be **removed from its current location no later than TUESDAY, JANUARY 31, 2023. You must submit a Removal Plan to the MDMR outlining your plan for removing the vessel from its current location no later than FRIDAY, JANUARY 27, 2023.**

The information contained in the attached guidelines must be included in the Removal Plan.

VESSEL DESCRIPTION: Vessel name is unknown, capsized white with black bottom, approximately 25', fiberglass hull boat,

VESSEL LOCATION: N 30\*11.240 089\*28.391, Heron Bay, Hancock County, MS

VESSEL REGISTRATION: Unknown

VESSEL OWNER: Unknown

Should the vessel not be removed **TUESDAY, JANUARY 31, 2023**, the MDMR will proceed with the prosecution of the matter making you a defendant seeking all costs of removal, which includes the recovery of expenses incurred as a result of, or incidental to, removal, storage, and restoration of affected lands, attorney's fees, court costs, penalties and damages up to FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00) per day for every day the vessel was left derelict, **beginning on the day the notice was posted on the vessel.**
