MDMR certifies fish records for November

BILOXI, Miss. – The Mississippi Department of Marine Resources certified two state fishing records using conventional tackle for the month of November.

Stefanson Smith of New Orleans set the record for Florida Pompano (*Trachinotus carolinus*) with a fish weighing 5 pounds, 0.64 ounces. Cecily O'Brien of Pascagoula set the record for Irish Pompano (*Diapterus auratus*) with a fish weighing 5.9 ounces.
