Introduction

The Mississippi Department of Marine Resources ("MDMR") is currently seeking an intern for the Office of Marine Patrol. The MDMR's Office of Marine Patrol provides marine enforcement of federal and state laws and the ordinances of the MDMR for the protection, preservation and conservation of Mississippi's seafood, aquatic life and associated coastal wetlands habitats. Marine Patrol also carries out the enforcement of state and federal laws pertaining to boating safety and provides emergency assistance concerning the state's marine environment.

The MDMR manages all marine life, public trust wetlands, adjacent uplands, and waterfront areas to provide for the balanced commercial, recreational, educational, and economic uses of these resources consistent with environmental concerns and social changes.

Scope of Work/Job Duties

The scope of work/job duties for this position will include:

- Coordinating youth programs aimed at exposing youth to the marine waters, islands and tributaries of Mississippi;
- Shadowing Marine Patrol Officers in daily patrols; and,
- Other duties as assigned by the Supervisor and/or Office Director.

Minimum Qualifications

The minimum qualifications the MDMR is seeking for the position include:

- **Education:** Must possess or be pursuing a Bachelors' Degree from an accredited fouryear college or university. If pursuing a degree, the candidate must have enough hours to be classified as a junior or senior. As part of the application, please provide a copy of your transcript (unofficial copy is acceptable).
- Experience: Two (2) years of experience related to the described duties, such as public interactions. Substitution Statement: Related education and related experience may be substituted on an equal basis. Please include any training or skills related to this position in your application.
- Other: Must possess a valid driver's license (Mississippi residents must have a Mississippi driver's license) or driver's license from a contiguous state. Applicants should have completed the Mississippi Boater Safety Course, if born after 1980. MDMR will verify the driver's license and completion of the Boater Safety Course.

Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities

The candidate should have knowledge of the coastal waterways and islands. The candidate should have good communication and organization skills. The ideal candidate should demonstrate the ability to implement multiple project tasks simultaneously and the ability to work effectively with others. This position requires working outdoors and often in uncomfortable environments (i.e. hot, humid, inclement weather).

Compensation and Hours Worked

The internship position pays \$14.00 per hour and is for 120.4 hours per month. The position is for up to 10 weeks, depending on the intern's school schedule.
