About the Position

This role encompasses mid-level technical responsibilities within the Finfish Bureau of the Mississippi Department of Marine Resources, focusing on warm water marine species for the purpose of rearing juveniles for stock enhancement and scale commercial grow out. Strong interpersonal skills, intermediate computer skills, excellent observational and problem-solving skills required. Weekend, evening, and holiday hours as needed with considerable work outside and in humid building environments.

What you'll need to be Successful

The technician will assist with analyzing and processing water quality samples, data recording, and record keeping. Field work as needed for collecting, tagging, releasing, or monitoring animals. General maintenance and operation of equipment, general lab and facility organization and cleanliness. Assisting co-workers as needed with execution and reporting of experiments and results. The position requires an individual that can endure the rigors of physically challenging tasks often performed under these conditions and the ability to lift 30 pounds. This position will require interaction with faculty, staff, research scientists and some interaction with the public. The ideal candidate should demonstrate the ability to implement multiple project tasks simultaneously and the ability to work effectively with others.
