MDMR certifies state saltwater finfish records for January

BILOXI, Miss. – The Mississippi Department of Marine Resources certified two state saltwater fishing records for the month of January.

For conventional tackle, Vince Wray of Vancleave set the record for Common Snook (*Centropomus undecimalis*) with a fish weighing 15.36 ounces.

For youth conventional tackle, Zachary Broussard, 11, of Biloxi set the record for Common Snook (*Centropomus undecimalis*) with a fish weighing 8.96 ounces.
